**YEAR 9 Key Stage 3 ART**

**Year 9 students rotate half termly within the creative arts subjects equating to a term each of Art, Music**

<b>Thematic unit</b>	<b>Classwork</b>	<b>Homework</b>
Week 1	Rules and expectations. Introduction to Food and Drink project. Look at the Pop Artist Andy Warhol and produce own colour version of 'Campbell's soup can'	Draw an item of Food or Drink packaging
Week 2	Observational drawing from still-life set up on the theme of Food and Drink	
Week 3	Pupils select an interesting area of their drawings to enlarge using a viewfinder. Pupils paint into their selected areas and experiment with a range of mark making techniques	Draw the inside of a piece of fruit or vegetable using colour
Week 4	A3 tonal observational drawing of a cut fruit or vegetable	
Week 5	Using tracing paper, divide the original drawing into 4 and paint each section in 3 pairs of complementary colours and black and white	Produce a portrait using fruit and vegetables in the style of the artist Archimboldo (AFL)
Week 6	Select one section and develop into a poly print.	
Week 7	Print and self-evaluate work

**YEAR 9 Key Stage 3 ART**

<b>Still life Problem Solving</b>	<b>Classwork</b> In this unit pupils will develop their drawing skills and extend their experience of a range of materials and processes. They will make connections to artists and analyse their own and others' work. They will solve problems such as representing 3D objects in 2D form and translating their ideas through 3D processes	<b>Homework</b>
Week 1	Use line and tone to produce a drawing from themed objects/still life	Create own still life at home and draw using line and tone and the full range of mark making techniques
Week 2	Divide the image in half and complete one half in pen and ink	Research and present information on an artist who paints still life
Week 3	Complete the other half of the image in oil pastel	Produce a painting in the style of the artist studied
Week 4-5	Abstract an area of the drawing and enlarge onto card. Build up the image using papier mache techniques	
Week 6	Paint the papier mache image	
Week 7	Complete and evaluate images
